Position Overview

The Bearizona Animal Staff-Drive Through Section- is hiring for a permanent position starting in August of 2026. Animal Staff cares for a variety of North American animals including Rocky Mountain Goats, reindeer, mule deer, Coues deer, burro, wolves, bison, pronghorn, bighorn sheep, and American black bears, as well as provide education and ensure guest safety while in the drive through.

Specific duties and responsibilities

- Provide daily husbandry to all assigned animals
- Observe and monitor animals' general health, reporting any abnormalities
- Participate in daily animal training sessions utilizing operant conditioning techniques
- Perform educational animal talks for guests
- Communicate effectively with other park staff
- Complete other duties as assigned

Preferred qualifications

- Ability to remain focused and friendly during repetitive interactions
- Hard-working, dependable, and a team player.
- Good communication skills
- Patience with the public
- Ability to follow directions accurately

Requirements

- Must be at least 16 years of age
- Must pass a background check
- Must have a clean drug test on hire date and throughout employment
- Work in all weather conditions and on uneven terrain
- Must be able to stand for long periods
- Must be able to work weekends and holidays
- Must have a reliable means of transportation
